#### **ENERGY STAR Background Information**

EPA's ENERGY STAR helps consumers, businesses, and public organizations protect the environment through superior energy efficiency. ENERGY STAR for Homes promotes energy-efficient homes that can improve builder profitability, improve home quality and homeowner comfort, lower energy demand, and reduce air pollution. ENERGY STAR qualified homes are third-party verified to be significantly more energy efficient than homes built to code.\* Savings are typically achieved through a combination of envelope upgrades, high performance windows, controlled air infiltration, upgraded heating and air conditioning systems, tight duct systems, upgraded waterheating equipment, and efficient lighting and appliances.

#### **ENERGY STAR's Commitments to Partners**

- Increase awareness of the ENERGY STAR label by distributing key messages on the benefits of ENERGY STAR qualified homes and homes-related products.

- 2. BUILDER PARTNERS: Provide a home energy rating report or relevant Builder Option Package for any qualified home upon EPA's request.
- 3. MANUFACTURED HOMES PARTNERS: "Comply with all current performance guidelines (as documented on the ENERGY STAR Homes web site) for designing, manufacturing, installing, and certifying ENERGY STAR qualified manufactured homes. For plants this includes becoming certified to produce ENERGY STAR qualified manufactured homes by a third-party certifier who has been accredited by an EPA-approved Quality Assurance Provider."

#### **General Terms and Disclaimers**

- 1. The partner will not construe, claim, or imply that its participation in ENERGY STAR constitutes federal government approval, acceptance, or endorsement of anything other than the partner's commitment to ENERGY STAR. Partnership does not constitute federal government endorsement of the partner or its homes or services.
- The partner understands that the activities it undertakes in connection with ENERGY STAR are voluntary and not intended to provide services to the federal government. As such, the partner will not submit a claim for compensation to any federal agency.
