Dear ENERGY STAR Imaging Equipment Stakeholder:

For your review, please find attached the First Draft Imaging Equipment Operational Mode (OM) Test Procedure and accompanying rationale. EPA welcomes your comments on these documents and asks that you direct feedback to Andrew Fanara, EPA, at fanara.andrew@epa.gov by **June 15, 2005**. This test procedure has been created based on stakeholder feedback on the existing OM test procedures from the Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs), which were distributed on June 30 and September 23, 2004 for comment.

In addition, please continue to submit information on products that qualify under the existing ENERGY STAR imaging equipment MOUs and test procedures using the Online Product Submittal (OPS) tool at www.energystar.gov/ops. In September 2005, EPA plans to refer to the data in the ENERGY STAR database for developing the draft OM specification criteria for the products addressed by the OM approach. EPA will assume that the data in the system at that time is fully up-to-date and correct. Please note that any **non-qualifying** product data submitted by manufacturers in response to the request originally distributed on April 16, 2004 will also be considered as part of the specification criteria development. When updating product data via OPS, EPA encourages partners to include optional data not required under the existing Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs), including standby wattage data, which will not only help EPA in the specification development process, but will also benefit consumers and purchasers who access this information on the ENERGY STAR Web site.

Please reply to this message if you have any difficulties opening the attached files. EPA would like to thank stakeholders who have submitted Typical Electricity Consumption (TEC) interim color test data, which will allow for the finalization of the TEC Test Procedure. If any stakeholders are in the process of completing this additional testing and would still like to submit this data to EPA, please provide a timeframe for when this data can be expected.
