Dear Furnace Manufacturer or Other Interested Party:

The purpose of this letter is to confirm that the Tier 2 for oil furnaces contained in the Version 2.0 ENERGY STAR[®] Specification for Furnaces went into effect on October 1, 2008. Gas furnaces are not affected by this change.

Under Tier 2, oil furnaces must meet 85% AFUE in order to qualify for the ENERGY STAR label. EPA is in the process of removing all oil furnace models that do not meet the 85% AFUE requirement from the ENERGY STAR Qualifying Products List maintained at <u>www.energystar.gov/products</u>. Should you have any additional oil furnace models that meet the 85% AFUE level, please submit that information to <u>furnaces@icfi.com</u> using the ENERGY STAR Qualifying Product Information Form for Furnaces found at <u>www.energystar.gov</u>.
