



## SEPTEMBER 2014 UPDATE

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is pleased to provide the **2014 ENERGY STAR® Summary of Appliance Programs** (Summary). The Summary provides an overview of a variety of programs offered by utilities and other energy efficiency program sponsors in the United States to promote ENERGY STAR certified commercial and residential clothes washers, clothes dryers, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, refrigerators, freezers, room air conditioners (room ACs), room air cleaners and purifiers, and water coolers. The Summary includes information provided by energy efficiency program sponsors and describes their current program offerings in 2014-2015 and beyond.

Each ENERGY STAR appliance program is summarized with a focus on incentives (e.g., mail-in rebates, recycling), marketing and consumer education efforts, program contacts, and other relevant program details. Participation in the Summary is voluntary and therefore does not represent all promotions and incentives available across the country.

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## Executive Summary

The 2014 ENERGY STAR Summary of Appliance Programs (Summary) presents information submitted by 160 energy efficiency program sponsors from across the United States, including 14 “umbrella organizations” and statewide programs running promotions on behalf of or in conjunction with 227 cooperative or municipal utilities and investor-owned utilities. Partners have provided information on 1,568 individual incentive and promotion programs for ENERGY STAR appliances including commercial and residential clothes washers, clothes dryers, dishwashers, dehumidifiers, refrigerators, freezers, room ACs, room air cleaners and purifiers, water coolers, and a variety of other equipment. To improve the accuracy of available promotions nationwide, information submitted under umbrella organizations has been accounted for individually for each member utility, unless otherwise indicated as a statewide or centrally-administered program.

From the information submitted by energy efficiency program sponsors, the key highlights include:

**Program Budgets** – Partners were asked to categorize their program budgets into buckets demonstrating order of magnitude and range (e.g., less than \$50K, \$1-\$5 million, \$5-\$10 million). To increase granularity of data collected in 2014, partners were given additional options for budget buckets. To calculate state totals and the national total, the mid-point of each bucket range was taken and multiplied by the total number of partner programs identifying with a given bucket. Since exact budget information has not been provided, nor have all partners given budget information (see the [Appliance Program and Budget Map](#) on page 3 for more details), a precise total cannot be determined; however, the trend in appliance program budgets appears to be upward. In 2011, based on the midpoint calculation, appliance programs were funded at about \$208 million. In 2012, that number increased to about \$222 million and in 2013, the national total was just under \$224 million. In 2014, the national budget increased to \$271 million. Due to the additional budget bucket detail available to partners this year compared to previous years, it is impossible to say whether this increased budget continues to represent an upward trend or a correction in the data from previous years.

**Promotions by Dollar Amount** – Promotion amounts in 2014 range from \$10 for dehumidifiers and room air conditioners to \$525 for evaporative coolers (a non-ENERGY STAR product). The average incentives for clothes washers, freezers, and refrigerators, along with dehumidifiers and room ACs recycling decreased from 2013, while the average incentives for clothes dryers, room ACs, along with refrigerators and freezers recycling increased. The largest decrease was for freezers, which declined from \$36.71 in 2013 to \$28.64 in 2014. The largest increase was for advanced clothes dryers as part of ENERGY STAR’s Emerging Technology Award program, which increased from \$25.40 in 2013 to \$71.36 in 2014. The average incentives for dehumidifiers, dishwashers, and room air cleaners and purifiers remained consistent with 2013 promotion amounts. **Promotions by Product** – As in 2011-2013, incentives for clothes washers lead the group, representing 17% of appliance promotions. Incentives for refrigerators recycling (16%) follow closely behind with incentives for freezers recycling (11%), dishwashers (10%), refrigerators (10%), room air conditioners (10%), dehumidifiers (9%), and freezers (8%) following after that. The remainder is comprised of room air cleaners and purifiers and clothes dryers along with the “other” and “other recycling” categories comprised of various products. Refrigerators experienced the greatest decline in incentives percentage-wise with utilities offering 165 incentives for the product in 2014 compared to 256 in 2013. Refrigerators recycling experienced the greatest jump in incentives percentage-wise with utilities offering 244 incentives for the product in 2014 compared to 158 in 2013. 

**Promotions by Type** – Similar to 2011-2013, the vast majority of promotions, 66%, are mail-in rebates. Promotions for recycling have seen the largest growth increasing from 23% in 2013 to 31% in 2014 and partners submitted information on a few instant rebates for appliances, which may be a category to watch over the next year. Appliance promotions with bill credits, low-interest loans, manufacturer or retailer buy-downs, and midstream incentives account for the rest. **Promotions by Region** – Similar to 2011-2013, the Midwest region has the greatest number of appliance promotions with 1,110, an increase of 16 from 2013. The West region follows next with 190, which is an increase of 13 submissions from 2013. The Northeast (87) and Southeast (42) have increased total promotions by 5 each from 2013 while the Mid-Atlantic (79) and Southwest (60) have decreased total promotions. The map below show program budgets for appliance programs by state as reported by the energy efficiency program sponsors.





(2014 totals listed in parentheses)




**2014 ENERGY STAR Appliance Promotions by Product Type**

(Annual totals listed in parentheses)




