In your presentation on Enhanced Testing and Verification for Consumer Electronics and IT Products, on March 31, we noted your reference to the Computer Verification Testing Guide V 1.0 (on slide 16). It appears this guide was published in September 2009 (for Computers) and that verification testing would begin no sooner than July 2009. This procedure calls for verification testing to be performed by an ILAC signatory accredited laboratory, similar to the approach being proposed for all eligible Energy Star product categories. Can you advise if this guide has been put into effect or will it follow suit with overall program enhancements for later this year. If this was addressed in your presentation, please accept my apologies for catching it.
