Subject: On-going verification of STBs

Hello,

In the initial call last week, I asked a question about on-going verification of a product that has 100% of its production in a short period (a few months), and then it is not manufactured after that. It was stated in the call that such a product would be listed on the web site as being qualified on a particular date, but it would also be removed from the list of active products.

My follow-up question to that relates to on-going SW updates for such a product. Even though there will be no new manufacturing for that model, it will continue to receive SW upgrades that could impact its energy consumption. How will on-going SW updates for such a product factor in to on-going periodic verification given that the HW is no longer being manufactured?
