Please check our comments from Philips CL (HongKong/Shenzhen).

1. It is better to have some authorized labs in South China .
2. If manufacturers like ASD, Neon, TCL, Eastec, ARTS and etc. can fulfill the conditions required by Energy star, it is good that Energy Star can authorize these manufacturers to proceed the test. If this is workable, then how manufacturers apply for the certified labs? And What is the lead time?
3. What is the cost if manufactures want to apply for certified labs by Energy Star? If manufacturers can not apply, what is the cost that the authorized labs will charge per unit? And how many units per model should be sent to the labs for the testing? And how long it takes for the labs to complete the testing?
4. What is the detailed schedule from Energy Star to have assessment for the labs? How frequently Energy star will proceed the assessment and renew the authorization?
5. Are there any representatives from Energy Star from China? If Yes, how to contact?
6. We hope this Energy Star process with more simplicity so as more people get awareness for the Environmental protection.
