Dear ENERGY STAR[®] Partner:

Thank you for supporting the ENERGY STAR program. As a term of your ENERGY STAR partnership, EPA collects unit shipment data (USD) on an annual basis for program evaluation purposes. Attached, please find the USD collection form for calendar year 2012. This form must be completed and returned by <u>March 1, 2013</u>. Note, you will receive a separate version of this letter for each form you must submit.

As stated on the form, partners must provide USD for all ENERGY STAR qualified products they shipped to or within the United States from January 1, 2012 – December 31, 2012. If a particular model was qualified for ENERGY STAR for only part of the year, only count shipments of that model during that part of the year.

If your company shipped <u>no</u> qualified products to or within the United States in 2012, you are still required to submit this form. A checkbox you may tick to indicate zero shipments is included for this purpose. EPA plans to use this data only for program evaluation purposes. EPA will release this information only as aggregated data and otherwise only to the extent required by law.

When completing your USD form(s), it is very important that you follow the instructions on the form. Specifically, EPA requires you to report shipments to or within the U.S. of **all models qualified under your own ENERGY STAR partnership**. Further, to ensure no double counting occurs, **do not report shipments of products qualified under another company's partnership**, even if you are the Original Equipment Manufacturer of those products. As a reminder, any product sold under a brand name your company owns or licenses must be qualified under your ENERGY STAR partnership. To the extent you have labeled products as ENERGY STAR for a brand owner/licensee that <u>is not</u> an ENERGY STAR partner, please report your shipments of these products. Trade Associations Aggregating Data

Several trade associations have agreed to collect and aggregate USD from ENERGY STAR partners for select product categories. EPA encourages partners to submit their USD forms to these associations, as it allows for all data to be aggregated and masked before submittal to EPA. The following table lists these associations, the forms they are collecting, and whether they will accept forms from both their member organizations and non-members, or from only their members. If you are submitting data through one of these associations, **do not submit a duplicate data collection form to EPA**.

Submission Deadline and Partnership Implications

The submission of annual USD is a condition of partnership. If your company fails to submit data by <u>March 1, 2013</u>, your ENERGY STAR qualified products will be removed from the qualified products list on the ENERGY STAR website, and your company name will be removed from the partner list. EPA will restore products and company names to the website no sooner than early April, provided the partner has submitted its USD. If your company still has not submitted USD by <u>May 1, 2013</u>, you will no longer be able to qualify additional models as ENERGY STAR until you submit your USD.
