

Dear Ms Rebecca Duff,

We, Revent, have gone through the proposal and we have a comment regarding the paragraph below:

H. Rack (Roll-In) Oven: A high-capacity oven, fitted with a motor-driven mechanism for rotating one or more pan racks within the cavity.

Single Rack Oven: A rack oven that is able to hold up to 15 full-size sheet pans of product at a time.

Double Rack Oven: A rack oven that is able to hold two single racks or one double-width rack.

We think that the following sentence should be changed “Single Rack Oven: A rack oven that is able to hold up to 15 full-size sheet pans of product at a time” to “Single Rack Oven: A rack oven that is able to hold one full rack of sheet pans of product at a time”.

The reasoning for this is that the most ovens are capable of holding more than 15 full-size sheet pans and some ovens are more efficient with a high load. There should not a limit in the number of pans in the definition for a Rack oven.
