

***Sea Gull Lighting comments on the Final Draft Version 4.1 ENERGY STAR
Specification for Residential Light Fixtures,
August 1, 2007***

The issue is that the lamp is exempt from the ENERGY STAR warranty, but the ballast has to have a two year warranty. So where does that leave the integrated product? My recommendation is a one year because a combined warranty can only be as good as the shortest warranty on the individual components.
