First, the NAMA Energy Project Group has voted to accept your wording as proposed on January 28, 2004, which is as follows:

“The ENERGY STAR Remanufactured Vending Machine specifications shall commence on a date to be determine through industry discussions regarding the administration and implementation of this program.”

Secondly, before we agree on the whole Eligibility Criteria we have one last proposed revision having to do with certifying electrical safety and the ability to use other third party agencies. Attached is our proposed wording for the definitions of indoor and outdoor machines and for the Test Criteria were indoor and outdoor machines are mentioned again. As you will see there are not substantive changes just wording to allow third party certifying agencies to be used. On behalf of the Group I would appreciate it if you would have the EPA review these proposed changes and let me know if they are acceptable. If so, we can begin the implementation of the ENERGY STAR program for refrigerated beverage vending machines.

As you requested and we discussed I have reviewed the changes in the Eligibility Criteria you have made based on our comments. Even though the language is slightly different it conforms to the UL way in which they want their standards reference, I believe we have an agreement on the base document.
