

**Comments on Draft 2

There are a couple of items I would suggest we modify. Both are definitions.

- 1 F Glass Door Cabinet: The definition notes that all doors should have more than 50% glass on the surface total. I would suggest we say more than 50% surface for all doors on one side of a cooler on the front surface. The edges of the door should not be part of the calculations. There are glass door coolers on one side and solid door on the other side of pass through cabinets. On the front the doors are more than 90% glass, but on the rear it is a solid door. (45% of the total doors would not be considered as glass door.) This carries a double penalty. It has a full glass door and extra gasket area and would still be a solid door unit by this definition.

- 1 G Worktop Surface: The definition notes “A solid working surface and backsplash.” Why do we want to limit the top by noting a backsplash. Not all working surfaces have backsplashes. I would ask you to remove the “and backsplash” from the definition. We make the same cabinet with and without a backsplash. I would hope to list both.
