

Within the roof coatings' classification and definitions in the proposed 2.0 Roof Products Specification there is no mention of epoxy based roof coatings. Epoxy based roof coatings are as distinct as any of the other categories. Indeed they are true coatings.

Epoxy roof coatings are not water based and are not chemically related to elastomerics, acrylics or other latex family coatings neither are they related to polyurethane foams (SPF's or PUF's) nor any bitumen, tar or asphaltic suspension, emulsion, compound or whatever. An example is the product Polarhide. Will you assign a separate section to epoxy roof coating products or to which existing category is it contemplated to place epoxy roof coatings? We request a separate designation.
