



Action Items from November 28, 2007 ENERGY STAR® TV Stakeholder Call

Administrative

- EPA to develop and distribute a revised timeline for finalizing the Version 3.0 TV products specification. (Revised timeline included at the end of this document.)
- EPA will consult with its marketing team regarding marketing and education plans around the forthcoming Version 3.0 ENERGY STAR TV products specification.
- Stakeholders to submit, by Friday, November 30, 2007, specific comments on the revised proposals for:
 - Download Acquisition Mode (DAM)
 - TVs with a forced-menu option at initial set-up
 - TVs with Automatic Brightness Control (ABC)
 - TV monitors
- Stakeholders to submit, by Friday, December 7, 2007, specific comments on the revised On Mode proposal.

Public Alert

- EPA to schedule a follow-up call with John Merrell, Prima Technology, to discuss TVs that have a mechanism to store energy.

Forced Menu

- EPA to include, in the Draft Final specification, an example of language that manufacturers could use to explain that 'Home' mode is the mode that qualifies for ENERGY STAR, thereby negating the need for a second prompt asking users to confirm that they want to select the 'Retail' mode.
- EPA to clarify, in the Draft Final specification, that a second prompt asking users to confirm that they want to select the 'Retail' mode in a forced menu option only needs to occur the very first time that the TV is turned on.
- EPA to include the exact language from the revised version of IEC 62087, section 11.4.8, "Picture Level Adjustments," in the Draft Final specification.

TV Monitors

- EPA will reflect proposed changes to the TV monitor definition on page 4 of the Draft Final Specification, under Section 2) Qualifying Products.

Savings Estimates

- EPA to develop and distribute savings estimates based on the revised On Mode proposal that was distributed to stakeholders on November 26, 2007.

Use of IEC 62087

- EPA to assess all changes to IEC 62087 proposed for the ENERGY STAR TV products specification to date in light of feedback requesting that the Normative Sections of the standard be used exactly as written.

Revised Timeline for Finalization of the Version 3.0 ENERGY STAR TV Products Specification

Friday, November 30, 2007: Stakeholder comments due on the four revised proposals on: DAM, TVs with a forced-menu option at initial set-up, TVs with ABC, and, TV monitors.

Friday, December 7, 2007: Stakeholders comments due on the revised On Mode proposal.

Monday, December 17, 2007: EPA to distribute the Draft Final Version 3.0 TV products specification.

Friday, January 18, 2008: Stakeholder comments due on the Draft Final Version 3.0 TV products specification.

Monday, February 4, 2008: EPA to distribute the Final Version 3.0 ENERGY STAR TV products specification.

Saturday, November 1, 2008: Tier 1 of the Final Version 3.0 ENERGY STAR TV products specification to take effect.
