Both options below appear viable to me. However, I believe the superior option to be Method B.

If you recall, we are an appliance retailer and we have in the past manufactured combination washer dryers. Based on our experience selling these units, they are rarely used as stand-alone dryers. Rather, the typical customer uses these units to completely wash and dry their load of clothes, without interruption between the cycles.

With the above in mind, I believe Method B will produce more accurate data that will correlate closer with the "real-world" use or results experienced by the end users.
