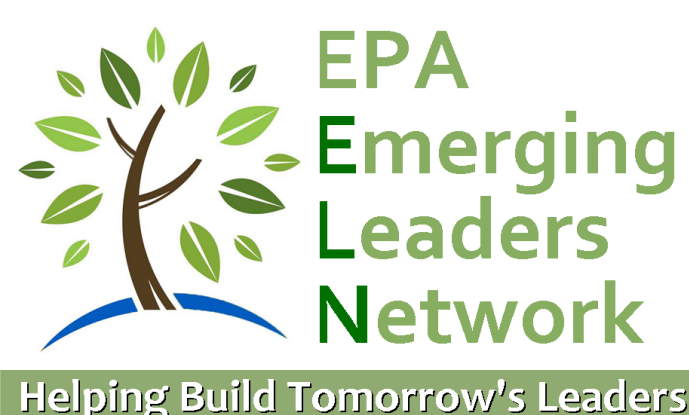
**Directions:** Enter on 14th St., South entrance, and bear to the right. The collection point will be the first bay on the left. There will be volunteers to help unload.
