We strive to be above our competition in our conservation efforts. Our Green Team meets monthly and continues to come up with innovative ways to keep us ahead of the game. Hyatt is a member of the International Tourism Partnership, which is dedicated to shaping tourism into a responsible, positive force for sustainable development, conservation and environmental protection.

- We have implemented paperless check-in
- Guest room amenity packaging is made from 100% recycled plastic
- Room keys made from 50% recycled plastic
- 30% recycled paper used for guest communication, hotel collateral and back of house

The following materials are recycled daily:

- Cooking Oil
- Glass
- Cardboard
- Paper
- Plastic
- Aluminum
- Batteries
- Light Bulbs

In addition to our recycling efforts we monitor our building systems in the following ways:

- Convention Center lighting is scheduled based on occupancy for the space
- Convention Center air conditioning is scheduled based on occupancy
- Guest rooms have digital thermostats to regulate the temperature
- We use compact fluorescent light bulbs in our guestrooms and at the pool/spa areas

Water Conservation:

- In order to reduce our water consumption, bed linens and towels will be changed every three days unless otherwise requested by the guest.
- Low-Flow shower heads, sink aerators, and toilet tank diverters minimize water waste on property.
- Our restaurants use the Natura Water System, an environmentally-friendly alternative to the waste associated with conventional bottled water.
