SEPTEMBER 2020 UPDATE

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is pleased to provide the **2020 ENERGY STAR® Summary of Appliance Programs** (Summary). The Summary provides an overview of programs offered by utilities and other energy efficiency program sponsors in the United States to promote ENERGY STAR certified commercial and residential clothes washers, clothes dryers, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, refrigerators, freezers, room air conditioners (room ACs), and room air cleaners and purifiers. The Summary includes information provided by energy efficiency program sponsors and describes their current program offerings in 2020-2021 and beyond.

Each ENERGY STAR appliance program is summarized with a focus on incentives (e.g., mail-in rebates, bill credits), program contacts, and other relevant program details. Participation in the Summary is voluntary and therefore may not represent all promotions and incentives available across the country. The information in this Summary is current as of July 1, 2020; more current or additional information may be available at www.energystar.gov/rebatefinder.

Executive Summary

The 2020 ENERGY STAR Summary of Appliance Programs (Summary) presents information submitted by 150 energy efficiency program sponsors from across the United States, including 10 “umbrella organizations” and statewide programs running promotions on behalf of or in conjunction with over 160 cooperative or municipal utilities and investor-owned utilities. Partners have provided information on 1,602 individual incentive and promotion programs for ENERGY STAR appliances including clothes washers, clothes dryers, dishwashers, dehumidifiers, refrigerators, freezers, room air conditioning, and room air cleaners and purifiers. To improve the accuracy of available promotions nationwide, information submitted under umbrella organizations has been accounted for individually for each member utility, unless otherwise indicated as a statewide or centrally administered program.

From the information submitted by energy efficiency program sponsors, the key highlights include:

Program Budgets - Partners were asked to categorize their program budgets into buckets demonstrating order of magnitude and range (e.g., less than \$50K, \$50-\$250K, \$250K-\$1 million). To calculate state totals and the national total, the midpoint of each bucket range was taken and multiplied by the total number of partner programs identifying with a given bucket. Since exact budget information has not been provided, nor have all partners elected to provide budget information (see the [Appliance Program and Budget Map](#) on page 4 for more details), a precise total cannot be determined. In 2016, based on the midpoint calculation, appliance programs were funded at about \$258 million, and in 2017, the national total increased to \$270 million. In 2018, the national total decreased to \$161 million. The decrease may be explained by a few key partners not submitting their program information, appliance programs ending in the last year, and/or because fewer partners have elected to provide budget data. In 2019, the national total increased to \$187 million, but in 2020, the total decreased slightly to \$149 million.

Promotions by Dollar Amount - Promotion amounts in 2019 range from \$5 for freezers, clothes dryers, and room air conditioners to \$750 for heat pump clothes dryers (compared to \$400 for clothes washers as the highest in 2019).

- The average incentive amount for refrigerators (2019 = \$54.14, 2020 = \$65.61) increased 21%, room ACs (2019 = \$30.66, 2020 = \$35.70) increased by 16%, and clothes washers (2019 = \$53.08, 2020 = \$60.27) increased by 14%. Some utilities, such as Efficiency Vermont and Lompoc City Electric increased their refrigerator incentives substantially as they shifted their program focus toward low-income customers. Clothes dryers (2019 = \$61.15, 2020 = \$85.64) had the largest increase, increasing by 40%. A major factor in this change were the much larger incentives for heat pump dryers that several utilities added to their programs in 2020.
- The average incentive for dishwashers (2019 = \$33.75, 2020 = \$32.66) decreased by 3% and freezers (2019 = \$39.00, 2020 = \$36.48) decreased by about 6% and were the only appliances with decreased incentives for purchasing new appliances.
- The remaining appliances all had their average incentives increase between 1% and 5%. Dehumidifiers (2019 = \$26.99, 2020 = \$27.87) increased by 3%, and room air cleaners (2019 = \$42.50, 2020 = \$42.93) increased by 1%.
- The average incentive amounts for appliance recycling programs all increased except for dehumidifiers (2019 = \$24.50, 2020 = \$23.33) which decreased by just under 5% after a 10% increase the year before.
- Both freezers and refrigerators recycling (2019 = \$44.05, 2020 = \$45.77) increased by 4%, staying at identical amounts for the third straight year.
- Room AC recycling (2019 = \$23.83, 2020 = \$26.29) had the largest increase at 10%.

Promotions by Product - In 2020, incentives for clothes washers lead the group representing 19% of the incentives available for new appliance purchases. This is an increase from 17% the year before. Total recycling, including refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, and room air conditioners, makes up 25% of all appliance incentives. The total number of refrigerator and freezer recycling incentives dropped, but several utilities raised the incentives amounts in response to COVID-19. The total number of recycling incentives for dehumidifiers and room air conditioners increased. Incentives for new refrigerator purchase represent 13% of total incentives. Dishwashers, freezers, clothes dryers, and room air conditioning each comprised between 5% and 9% of total promotions, while dehumidifiers represented 12%. The remainder of incentives offered are comprised of room air cleaners and purifiers and the “other” categories comprised of various products. 
Promotions by Type - Most promotions in 2020—89% of new product purchase and recycling incentives—are mail-in rebates. Appliance promotions with instant rebates, bill credits, low-interest loans, manufacturer or retailer buy-downs, free pick-up, and midstream incentives account for the rest. Promotions by Region - The Midwest region has the greatest number of appliance promotions with 816, which can be explained by the large number of small municipal and cooperative utilities offering appliance incentives in the region. This is down from 1,134 in 2019. Many of these smaller utilities and cooperatives in the Midwest dropped their recycling incentives, while Ohio utilities dropped most of theirs as well, contributing to the decrease. The Mid-Atlantic region follows next with 166 incentives, up from 140 in 2019. The Northeast had 145, up from 110 the year before. The West had 95 incentives, down from 96. The Southwest had 60, up from 55, and the Southeast decreased to 36, down from 45 the year before. See [“2020 ENERGY STAR Appliance Promotions by Type and Region”](#) on page 9 for more details.

The map below shows program budgets for appliance programs by state as reported by the energy efficiency program sponsors.





Average Promotion Amount for ENERGY STAR Appliances 2016-2020




2020 ENERGY STAR Appliance Promotions by Product Type
(Totals listed in parentheses)





(Annual totals listed in parentheses)


