ENERGY STAR Value

- Including the ENERGY STAR certification mark as a visible feature on marketing materials lends credibility, trust, and brand awareness. It serves as an implicit seal of approval and helps differentiate the product.
 - A 2017 study found JD Power Customer Satisfaction indexes for ENERGY STAR partners increased significantly over time compared to non-partners, particularly in the areas of Corporate Citizenship, Communications, and Customer Service.
 - A/B testing conducted by Focus on Energy shows that using the ENERGY STAR logo on ads drove a 60% increase in click- through rate.
- Partners should always use the certification mark when featuring ENERGY STAR certified products.

Dishwasher Messaging

Why Choose ENERGY STAR?

- Standard-size dishwashers that have earned the ENERGY STAR are approximately 20% more energy efficient and 30% more water efficient than standard models.
- An ENERGY STAR certified standard-sized dishwasher costs about \$50 per year to run and can save you about 5,800 gallons of water over its lifetime.
- Compact dishwashers that have earned the ENERGY STAR are approximately 30% more energy efficient and 40% more water efficient than conventional models.
- An ENERGY STAR certified compact dishwasher costs about \$20 per year to run and can save you about 4,850 gallons of water over its lifetime.
- Dishwasher technology has improved dramatically over the last decade and new ENERGY STAR certified models include several innovations like soil sensors, improved water filtration, more efficient jets, and dish rack designs that reduce energy and water consumption and improve performance.
- ENERGY STAR certified dishwashers are the right choice for the environment—they use 30%less water saving about 400 gallons of water each year.





Dishwasher Messaging

- Scrape, don't rinse! ENERGY STAR certified dishwashers and today's detergents are designed to do the cleaning so you don't have to. If your dirty dishes sit overnight, use your dishwasher's rinse feature. It uses a fraction of the water needed to hand rinse.
- Washing dishes in a new ENERGY STAR certified machine rather than hand washing can cut your utility bills by \$210 per year.
- A new ENERGY STAR certified dishwasher uses less than half as much energy as washing dishes by hand and saves 8,400 gallons of water a year.
- Using an ENERGY STAR certified dishwasher can save you about \$3,200 over its lifetime compared to handwashing your dishes. Dishwashers use significantly less water and energy, which is good for your wallet and good for the environment!

Buying Guidance

- Make sure to select the best dishwasher size for your needs.
 - Standard-capacity dishwasher models hold more than eight place settings and six serving pieces, and compact models generally hold less than eight to six serving pieces.
 - Due to their smaller capacity, compact models may use more energy than standard models over time.





Dishwasher Messaging

- Choose a dishwasher that has several different wash cycle options.
 - A dishwasher with an auto-sensing cycle, means the dishwasher has a soil-sensor and is able to detect if the water coming off the dishes is dirty or clean, which can save water and help ensure the dishes come out clean.
 - If selecting a dishwasher without a soil-sensor, look for models that have multiple cycle options so you can choose the cycle that best fits your load.
 - If your dishes are only slightly soiled, you can use a light cycle that uses less water. Other options might include an energy-saving wash cycle or the ability to turn off heated dry.
- Look for dishwashers that have earned ENERGY STAR Most Efficient recognition, as they deliver cutting edge energy efficiency along with the latest in technological innovation. You can find recognized dishwashers, here.

Dishwasher Savings: There always seems to be more dishes, but at least you can save money when washing them! Dishwashers that have earned the ENERGY STAR use 30% less water and 20% less energy than standard models, which is good for you and the environment. Save even more with a rebate from your local utility. <u>https://www.energystar.gov/productfinder/product/certified-residential-dishwashers/results</u>

Water Savings: ENERGY STAR certified dishwashers are the right choice for the environment—they use 30% less water saving about 400 gallons of water each year. But remember, dishwashers use about the same amount of energy and water regardless of the number of dishes inside, so run full loads whenever possible. <u>https://www.energystar.gov/products/dishwashers</u>

Energy Savings: Did you know that you could save MORE energy and money by using a dishwasher over hand washing? If you are looking for a new dishwasher, models that earn the ENERGY STAR use less than half as much energy as washing dishes by hand and must meet cleaning criteria to ensure they deliver energy savings without sacrificing performance. <u>https://www.energystar.gov/products/dishwashers</u>

Handwashing Tip: Using an ENERGY STAR certified dishwasher can save you about \$3,200 over its lifetime compared to handwashing your dishes. Best Practice: #Tip: Scrape--don't rinse! When loading your dishes, save water by scraping extra food off the plate instead of pre-rinsing. 




Dishwasher vs. Hand Washing Infographic
