



Federal Tax Credits for Energy Efficient Home Improvement Projects

Windows, Skylights, and Doors

The Inflation Reduction Act provides federal income tax credits that are specially targeted to home owners that make energy efficient home improvements involving windows, skylights, and doors - 30% of product costs, up to \$600 annually for windows and skylights, and up to \$500 annually for exterior doors (\$250 per door, up to 2 doors) for a total of \$1,100. Lower the cost of home improvement projects that are designed to save money on utility bills each month.

Tax Credits for Energy Efficiency Improvements

- **Total Annual Limit:** The \$600 window or skylight credit and the \$500 door credit (for 2 doors) can be combined with credits up to \$2,000 for other qualified upgrades made in one tax year. The taxpayer may not include the labor costs (product costs only).
- **Effective Date:** Products purchased and installed between January 1, 2023, and December 31, 2032.
- **Tax Credit:** An amount taxpayers can claim on their federal tax return to reduce income tax owed.
- **Who Qualifies:** Must be an existing home & principal residence (owned or rented) in the U.S. Does not apply for new construction and rental properties. The product(s) must reasonably be expected to remain in use for at least 5 years.
- **What to Keep:** Customers should keep their receipts and any relevant materials, such as product labels, that identify the purchased product.

Upgrading Windows, Skylights, and Doors in a Home

	Homeowner Can Claim	Maximum Credit Amount	What products are eligible? (Note: Eligibility varies by home location)
Windows	30% of product costs (no labor costs)	Up to \$600 per year	ENERGY STAR Most Efficient certified windows.
Skylights			ENERGY STAR Most Efficient certified skylights.
Exterior Doors	30% of product costs (no labor costs)	Up to \$500 per year for 2 doors (\$250 per door)	ENERGY STAR certified doors.
