Dear ENERGY STAR Residential New Construction Stakeholder,

As part of this year's annual revisions to the ENERGY STAR Single-Family New Homes (SFNH) and Multifamily New Construction (MFNC) program requirements, the EPA is soliciting feedback on several significant proposed changes. The primary goal of these proposed revisions is to simplify and streamline the program while also increasing the ability of Raters to consistently confirm that all requirements have been met. Like prior revisions, these proposals are not intended to significantly increase the stringency of the program requirements.

The EPA is soliciting stakeholder feedback from July 18, 2024 - August 15, 2024 on the key proposals for the next annual revision of the ENERGY STAR Single-Family New Homes and Multifamily New Construction programs.
