Products that earn the ENERGY STAR label meet strict energy-efficiency specifications set by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, helping you save energy and money while protecting the environment.

Many common household energy-using products carry the ENERGY STAR label, including:

- Appliances, such as refrigerators, dishwashers, washers, dryers, air purifiers, and dehumidifiers.
- Electronics such as televisions, laptops, and monitors.
- Heating and cooling equipment, like smart thermostats, ceiling fans, heat pump HVAC, and water heaters.

## Save Today

Utilities in most parts of the country offer rebates and discounts on ENERGY STAR certified products. Visit [energystar.gov/rebatefinder](https://energystar.gov/rebatefinder) to find rebates available near you.

States are now launching rebates that can be combined with utility rebates for even more savings on efficient home upgrades. These rebates are funded by the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) and provide **up to \$14,000 per home**. To qualify for the discounts, products must be ENERGY STAR certified and eligibility is based on income.
