Dear ENERGY STAR Verified HVAC Installation Program Stakeholder,

The U.S. EPA will sunset the ENERGY STAR Verified HVAC Installation (ESVI) program effective August 31, 2025.

The EPA believes in the importance of quality installation of HVAC equipment and will continue to promote its value on the ENERGY STAR website. In addition, the Air Conditioning Contractors of America (ACCA) will continue to advance HVAC quality installation through its [Residential Service and Installation \(RSI\) accreditation program](#) for contractors. Although the EPA will be sunsetting the ESVI program, ACCA's RSI accreditation program will continue to operate and provide a way for leading contractors to offer certified quality installations for homeowners.

With the planned discontinuation of the ESVI program, **the EPA is no longer approving applications to use the ESVI marks, and we ask that participating contractors review all electronic and printed marketing materials, identify and remove any use of the ESVI marks, and cease issuing ESVI certificates no later than August 31, 2025.** Concurrently, the EPA will be removing references to the ESVI program from the ENERGY STAR website.
