Hello Daniel,

This is Derek from Anbotek lab, I'm very glad to see the new specification version being worked out, it looks more clear and stricter. But I still have below slight points to be risen, just for your reference.

1. The latest version of chromaticity specification for SSL is ANSI C78.377-2017 instead of ANSI C78.377-2015, and the reference standard in Page 15 is not update.
2. For product families section, "Additional Test Data Required for Each Variant", whether the additional test could be accepted from manufacturer which will clear identify out the "worst case", since it will impact deeply for the test cost to manufacturer, hope it can be clarified.
