Dear ENERGY STAR® Commercial Coffee Brewer Manufacturer or Other Interested Party:

With this letter, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is finalizing the Version 1.1 amendments to the ENERGY STAR Commercial Coffee Brewer specification.

With the Version 1.1, EPA adjusted the normalized heavy-use brew energy performance requirement to accommodate a broader range of tank temperatures and removed the average holding temperature reporting requirement. The Agency also included clarification on the activation guidance of auxiliary electrical components during testing. EPA received broad support for these adjustments to the specification. Version 1.1 replaces the Version 1.0 specification effective immediately.
