LG Electronics appreciates the opportunity to provide comments, and we respectfully request that the EPA take these comments into consideration for the final of the Version 8 TV ENERGY STAR specification.

Effective Date

According to the revised final draft Version 8.0 TV specification, the effective date is July 1, 2018.

We propose to push back the effective date of V8.0. Manufacturers typically have 9 months to comply to a new version of ENERGY STAR specification after the final version is published. For example, if the final version is published November 30, 2017, the effective date should be after August 30, 2018.

Additionally, July 1, 2018 is not a good time for a new version of the TV spec to apply because most TV manufacturers introduce their new TV models after CES. We believe the most appropriate effective time for the Version 8 is March 2019. We respectfully request to postpone the effective date.
