Dear ENERGY STAR® Lighting Stakeholder:

This letter is to notify you that EPA has finalized minor changes to the ENERGY STAR Lamps specification as proposed in a [letter](#) to stakeholders on May 23, 2014. Details are available at www.energystar.gov/lamps.

The changes described in the proposal letters have been accepted as proposed, with a modification to the diameter to length ratio for globe lamps from 0.90 to 0.80 based on stakeholder feedback. These changes are reflected in an ENERGY STAR Specification for Lamps Version 1.1, which replaces the ENERGY STAR Specification for Lamps Version 1.0.

Partners may begin certifying to Version 1.1 requirements immediately. Currently certified products are not affected, with the exception of any products excluded based on the clarification of decorative globes.
