

Dear Lighting – Team,

Thanks for your hard work on the specifications and providing the webinars along with the development of the specifications.

In the lamps specification **section 15.1** is causing sometimes some irritations because of the wording and the intended idea behind.

The sentences to be reconsidered are in section '15.1. Lamp Labeling: All Lamps':

- Lamp rated lumen output in lumens (lamps not covered by FTC requirements)
- Lamp nominal beam angle in degrees (in lieu of lumen output for PAR and MR lamps)

Wouldn't it here be more appropriate to clearly address which type of lamp shall follow what part of the requirements?

It is understood that there shall be no printing (not considering now the FTC aspect):

- for the nominal beam angle on the non-directional lamps and decorative lamps
- for rated lumen output for MR and PAR lamps

Suggested more clear wording:

- Lamp rated lumen output in lumens (lamps not covered by FTC requirements and not for MR and PAR lamps)
- Lamp nominal beam angle in degrees – for directional lamps only

For the Lamps V2.0 **section 15.2** EPA seeks for input on the nomenclature for the new CCTs 2200K and 2500K.

Suggested descriptor could be:

- 2200K – Sunset light
- 2500K – Incandescent light

I would reserve the term: 'Candle light' for a possible CCT of 1900K
