Dear ENERGY STAR® Residential Water Heaters Brand Owner or Other Interested Party:

With this letter, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is finalizing the Version 3.2 amendments to the ENERGY STAR Residential Water Heaters specification. EPA received no comments on its proposed amendments to the specification and, as such, is proceeding with these changes. Currently certified products are not affected by the changes.

Products certified from this point forward should use Version 3.2, including a 2.20 UEF requirement for all electric storage water heaters larger than 55 gallons and the addition of solar photovoltaic water heaters in scope.
