

Dear [Name of ENERGY STAR Commercial Food Service Partner]:

The purpose of this email is to clarify the intention of the "Total U.S. Unit Shipments (ENERGY STAR + Non-ENERGY STAR)" column in the commercial food service equipment Unit Shipment Data collection form(s) the U.S. EPA sent you on Monday, January 9, 2012. By "Non-ENERGY STAR," EPA is referring to models the Product Type column addresses but which are simply not qualified, for example, because they do not meet ENERGY STAR performance requirements. In other words, when you fill in the Total U.S. Unit Shipments column, please count only those models that the Product Type column enumerates.

If you have already submitted your commercial food service form(s), and your entries in the Total U.S. Unit Shipments column do not conform to these instructions, please submit your corrected form(s) by March 1.
