Kentucky is home to about **290** businesses and organizations that participate in U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR program, including:

- 9** manufacturers of ENERGY STAR certified products
- 16** companies supporting independent certification of ENERGY STAR products and homes
- 19** companies building ENERGY STAR certified homes, and many businesses, schools, governments, and faith-based groups using ENERGY STAR to avoid energy waste.

Across Kentucky in 2019

- 1.5 million customers** were served by ENERGY STAR utility and energy efficiency program partners
- 2,083 buildings** (almost 182 million square feet) were benchmarked using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager
- 12,551 homes** have earned the ENERGY STAR to date
- 770 buildings** have earned the ENERGY STAR for superior efficiency to date, including 466 schools, 4 hotels, 9 hospitals, 91 office buildings, and 6 industrial plants.
