Louisiana is home to about **90** businesses and organizations that participate in U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR program, including:

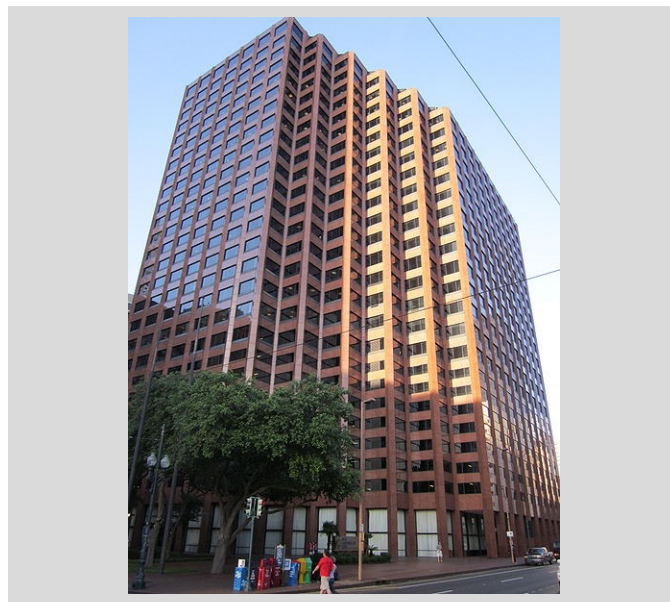
- 2** manufacturers of ENERGY STAR certified products
- 9** companies supporting independent certification of ENERGY STAR products and homes
- 32** companies building ENERGY STAR certified homes, and many businesses, schools, governments, and faith-based groups using ENERGY STAR to avoid energy waste.

### Across Louisiana in 2019

- 1.6 million customers** were served by ENERGY STAR utility and energy efficiency program partners
- 1,917 buildings** (more than 139 million square feet) were benchmarked using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager
- 10,722 homes** have earned the ENERGY STAR to date
- 146 buildings** have earned the ENERGY STAR for superior efficiency to date, including 62 schools, 3 hotels, 4 hospitals, 33 office buildings, and 6 industrial plants.
