## Families and businesses are saving with the help of ENERGY STAR®

North Dakota is home to about **30** businesses and organizations that participate in U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR program, including:

- 2** manufacturers of ENERGY STAR certified products
- 3** companies building ENERGY STAR certified homes, and many businesses, schools, governments, and faith-based groups using ENERGY STAR to avoid energy waste.

### Across North Dakota in 2019

**238 thousand customers** were served by ENERGY STAR utility and energy efficiency program partners

**284 buildings** (more than 15 million square feet) were benchmarked using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager

**726 homes** have earned the ENERGY STAR to date

**42 buildings** have earned the ENERGY STAR for superior efficiency to date, including 3 schools, 1 hotel, 2 hospitals, 5 office buildings, and 2 industrial plants.



The oldest ENERGY STAR certified building in North Dakota is one of the first JC Penney stores, built in 1925.

### State Spotlight

The J.R. Simplot Company, Grand Forks industrial plant (frozen fried potato processing) received ENERGY STAR certification in 2019 for superior energy performance.
