Nebraska is home to about **100** businesses and organizations that participate in U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR program, including:

- 2** manufacturers of ENERGY STAR certified products
- 6** companies supporting independent certification of ENERGY STAR products and homes
- 18** companies building ENERGY STAR certified homes, and many businesses, schools, governments, and faith-based groups using ENERGY STAR to avoid energy waste.

Across Nebraska in 2019


- 1.1 million customers** were served by ENERGY STAR utility and energy efficiency program partners
- 1,108 buildings** (more than 100 million square feet) were benchmarked using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager
- 4,093 homes** have earned the ENERGY STAR to date
- 148 buildings** have earned the ENERGY STAR for superior efficiency to date, including 38 schools, 1 hotel, 3 hospitals, 45 office buildings, and 3 industrial plants.
