New Mexico is home to about **70** businesses and organizations that participate in U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR program, including:

- 3** manufacturers of ENERGY STAR certified products
- 5** companies supporting independent certification of ENERGY STAR products and homes
- 18** companies building ENERGY STAR certified homes, and many businesses, schools, governments, and faith-based groups using ENERGY STAR to avoid energy waste.

Across New Mexico in 2019

- 737 thousand customers** were served by ENERGY STAR utility and energy efficiency program partners
- 1,429 buildings** (more than 69 million square feet) were benchmarked using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager
- 10,866 homes** have earned the ENERGY STAR to date
- 298 buildings** have earned the ENERGY STAR for superior efficiency to date, including 179 schools, 1 hotel, 5 hospitals, 39 office buildings, and 1 industrial plant.
