Tennessee is home to about **250** businesses and organizations that participate in U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR program, including:


- 15** manufacturers of ENERGY STAR certified products
- 35** companies supporting independent certification of ENERGY STAR products and homes
- 58** companies building ENERGY STAR certified homes, and many businesses, schools, governments, and faith-based groups using ENERGY STAR to avoid energy waste.

Across Tennessee in 2019

- 8.2 million customers** were served by ENERGY STAR utility and energy efficiency program partners
- 3,788 buildings** (more than 368 million square feet) were benchmarked using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager
- 16,351 homes** have earned the ENERGY STAR to date
- 480 buildings** have earned the ENERGY STAR for superior efficiency to date, including 105 schools, 1 hotel, 6 hospitals, 124 office buildings, and 8 industrial plants.
