ENERGY STAR Activity in Connecticut

- 1.7 million customers** served by ENERGY STAR utility partners in 2021
- 4,438 buildings** (almost 254 million square feet) benchmarked using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager in 2021
- 13,700 homes and apartments** earned the ENERGY STAR to-date
- 324 buildings** earned the ENERGY STAR to-date, including 81 schools, 5 hotels, 3 hospitals, and 93 office buildings.
