Kentucky is home to **270** businesses and organizations participating in U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR program:

- 8** manufacturers of ENERGY STAR certified products
- 14** companies supporting independent certification of ENERGY STAR products, homes, and apartments
- 13** companies building ENERGY STAR certified homes and apartments and many businesses, schools, governments, and faith-based groups using ENERGY STAR to reduce energy waste.

ENERGY STAR Activity in Kentucky

1.5 million customers served by ENERGY STAR utility partners in 2021

2,025 buildings (almost 159 million square feet) benchmarked using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager in 2021

14,300 homes and apartments earned the ENERGY STAR to-date

805 buildings earned the ENERGY STAR to-date, including 484 schools, 4 hotels, 9 hospitals, 95 office buildings and 7 industrial plants.

State Spotlights

Kenton County School District, a school district in Kentucky, saved nearly \$1.7 million in energy costs and earned ENERGY STAR certification for nine schools in 2021, and achieved both a 40% reduction in energy use and lower energy costs since 2005.

Schneider Electric, an energy management and automation services company, supported organizations in benchmarking more than 57,000 properties, an increase of more than 30% in 2021.

Bullitt County Public Schools, a school district in Kentucky, saved over \$1.1 million in energy costs, received ENERGY STAR certification for 15 schools, and increased the district average ENERGY STAR score to 90 in 2021, as well as engaged students across 16 schools in energy teams to analyze ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager data.

Scott County Schools, a school district in Kentucky, achieved ENERGY STAR certification at 14 schools in 2021, and has saved more than \$9.4 million in energy costs since 2010.
