ENERGY STAR Activity in Maine

782 thousand customers served by ENERGY STAR utility partners in 2021

704 buildings (almost 30 million square feet) benchmarked using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager in 2021

2,900 homes and apartments earned the ENERGY STAR to-date

87 buildings earned the ENERGY STAR to-date, including 11 schools, 2 hospitals, 18 office buildings and 2 industrial plants.
