902 thousand customers served by ENERGY STAR utility partners in 2021

5,200 homes and apartments earned the ENERGY STAR to-date

91 buildings earned the ENERGY STAR to-date, including 31 schools, 3 hospitals, 3 office buildings and 3 industrial plants.
