Oklahoma is home to **70** businesses and organizations participating in U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR program:

- 7** manufacturers of ENERGY STAR certified products
- 7** companies supporting independent certification of ENERGY STAR products, homes, and apartments
- 7** companies building ENERGY STAR certified homes and apartments and many businesses, schools, governments, and faith-based groups using ENERGY STAR to reduce energy waste.

ENERGY STAR Activity in Oklahoma

1.3 million customers served by ENERGY STAR utility partners in 2021

1,209 buildings (almost 126 million square feet) benchmarked using EPA's ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager in 2021

18,300 homes and apartments earned the ENERGY STAR to-date

255 buildings earned the ENERGY STAR to-date, including 118 schools, 3 hotels, 6 hospitals, 39 office buildings and 6 industrial plants.

State Spotlights

Public Service Company of Oklahoma, an electric utility company, expanded its ENERGY STAR certified homes and products programs across its service territory and outperformed its original energy savings goal by 84%.

Tulsa was one of the Top Mid-Size Cities for ENERGY STAR certified buildings, with 28 buildings.

Indian Health Service - Edmond Business Park, an office building in Oklahoma City, earned ENERGY STAR certification for the 10th time in 2021.
