

Andrew Bierman is a Senior Scientist at the Lighting Research Center (LRC) and an Adjunct Assistant Professor in the School of Architecture at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. His research activities are in the areas of vision psychophysics, lighting controls, and the measurement of lighting efficacy. Research activities include improving photosensors, development of a load-shedding fluorescent lighting system, and research into the non-imaging effects of light on human physiology and well-being via the circadian system. In addition to his research activities, he maintains the photometric laboratory facilities at the LRC.
