CEE is not planning to submit written feedback at this point, but we greatly value EPA's efforts to seek input from such an early stage, and look forward to being actively involved moving forward.

In short response to some of the topics outlined during the December 12th, 2014 Stakeholder Meeting:

- Increased transparency and sharing of background materials helps us better analyze information and assess the potential impact to programs;
- EPA's Guiding Principles serve as effective backdrop for driving the direction of the ENERGY STAR program; and
- Cost-Effectiveness remains a key consideration for many members, and addressing the issues that EPA has outlined may help enable programs to promote products.

We expect to develop more formal comments at future stages in the ENERGY STAR process, and appreciate the steps that EPA is taking to promote dialogue with windows, doors, and skylights stakeholders. Please let me know if I can provide any additional information or detail at this point.
