SUBJECT: ENERGY STAR Roof Products Sunset

Date: 07/16/2019

As indicated in <u>EPA's announcement</u> to sunset the ENERGY STAR Roof Products specification, EPA-recognized Certification Bodies may no longer certify new roof products as ENERGY STAR as of June 1, 2021. Modifications to existing certifications will continue to be permitted from June 1, 2021 to June 1, 2022 as partners take steps to stop labeling products as ENERGY STAR. Certifications will remain valid until June 1, 2022, when the list of ENERGY STAR certified roof models will be removed from the ENERGY STAR lists of certified models and archived on the website. Note that EPA is no longer accepting new partners for ENERGY STAR roof products as of the date of the announcement on May 28, 2019.

EPA-Recognized Laboratories may continue to test products in accordance with the ENERGY STAR Roof Products V3.0 specification through Spring 2021, but need to ensure that clients are aware of Certification Body deadlines relevant to products being certified as ENERGY STAR prior to June 1, 2021.

Accreditation Bodies are expected to ensure that Certification Bodies and Laboratories continue to follow all aspects of their accreditation to the ENERGY STAR scheme. Please note that EPA has suspended the standard verification testing required each year for Roof Products and as such they have been excluded from the 2019 list of <u>verification testing responsibilities</u>. Verification testing will only be required on an ad hoc basis as needed.
