At this time, your home has been verified to meet a majority of the requirements of the ENERGY STAR Residential New Construction program. However, due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation, the onsite diagnostic tests required by the program have not yet been performed. These important tests, which can be completed by your builder's home energy rater at a later date, are required for your home to earn the ENERGY STAR label.
