What is ENERGY STAR?



ENERGY STAR is the simple choice for energy efficiency. For more than 25 years, EPA's ENERGY STAR program has been America's resource for saving energy and protecting the environment.



How Saving Energy Helps Protect the Environment

- The **power of the individual** makes a difference!
- ENERGY STAR is **the environmental choice that provides energy savings without compromising performance** or comfort.
- ENERGY STAR is **a government-backed symbol** that means labeled products have been independently certified to use less energy than comparable products and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

ENERGY STAR Sales Value

Consumer awareness and desire for efficiency savings are high.

Approximately **half (45%) of U.S. households knowingly purchased** an ENERGY STAR certified product in the past year.

Of households that purchased ENERGY STAR certified products in the past year:

- **74 percent** reported the label as **influential** in their purchasing decision;
- **80 percent** reported that they are **likely to recommend** products that have earned the ENERGY STAR to friends.

The Customer's Opportunity: Saving Energy = Saving Money

- 20.5 million older refrigerators still in use throughout the U.S.
- On average, an older refrigerator uses **twice** as much energy as a new ENERGY STAR certified refrigerator.
- Many utilities and energy efficiency program sponsors are rebating and promoting ENERGY STAR certified refrigerators and freezers.
- Help your customers save money with ENERGY STAR certified refrigerators and freezers by using less energy.



ENERGY STAR certified refrigerators and freezers use less energy and cost less to operate resulting in **lower utility bills**. For added savings show customers [available rebates](#).



What Makes an ENERGY STAR Certified Refrigerator or Freezer?

- Increased savings
- Improved technology and features
- A commitment to protecting the environment

Refrigerator and freezer efficiency is measured by **Annual Energy Consumption (AEC) kWh/year.**

- AEC is a measure of the estimated energy use of the refrigerator or freezer per year. The lower the value, the less energy the refrigerator or freezer uses.
- To qualify for ENERGY STAR certification, the AEC must be less than or equal to a Maximum Annual Energy Consumption (MAEC) for the type of refrigerator or freezer, based on the size and configuration.

The ENERGY STAR label recognizes a selection of highly efficient refrigerator and freezer models from leading manufacturers in many different configurations, including top-freezer, bottom-freezer, side-by-side, and compact.

ENERGY STAR Certified Refrigerator and Freezer Savings

- By properly recycling your old refrigerator and replacing it with a new ENERGY STAR certified model, you could **save more than \$270** over the next five years.
- ENERGY STAR certified refrigerators are about **9 percent** more efficient than standard models.
- *If all residential refrigerators sold in the United States were ENERGY STAR certified, the **utility cost savings would grow to nearly \$700 million each year** and 9 billion pounds of annual greenhouse gas emissions would be prevented. This is **equivalent to the emissions from more than 870,000 vehicles.***





Is Your Customer Concerned About the Environment?

Listen

- I need a new refrigerator, but it needs to be energy efficient.
- My refrigerator is old and probably using a lot of energy. I'm concerned about my environmental footprint.



Tell

Tell your green customers about ENERGY STAR certified refrigerators:


- "ENERGY STAR certified refrigerators help prevent climate change. The U.S. EPA estimates that if all refrigerators sold in the U.S. were ENERGY STAR certified, **9 billion pounds of greenhouse gas emissions** would be avoided, equivalent to the emissions from more than **870,000 vehicles each year.**"
- "A new ENERGY STAR certified refrigerator uses **less energy than a 60-watt light bulb.**"
- "ENERGY STAR is the simple choice: **save energy, save money, and help protect the climate.**"



Have a Customer Focused on Saving Money?

Listen

- My refrigerator is done, but money is tight. Can you point me to a cost-effective option to replace it?
- The options you have cost too much up front.
- I've been researching refrigerators and you have the cheapest models.



Tell

Tell your money-conscious customers about ENERGY STAR certified refrigerator savings:

"It's too much money up front."

- "ENERGY STAR certified refrigerators might cost more, but there may be [rebates](#) available in your area to offset the cost."
- "While the price might seem high upfront, the purchase price is only part of the cost. **ENERGY STAR certified refrigerators and freezers** save energy and money over the product's lifetime."
- "Replacing your older refrigerator with a new ENERGY STAR certified model could save you **more than \$270 over the next five years.**"



Have a Customer with Lots of Objections?

Listen

- How can I tell this “energy-efficient” refrigerator is saving for me?
- ENERGY STAR certified refrigerators sound great, but I’ve heard I can’t get one with the features I want.
- How do I know the product is truly ENERGY STAR?

Tell

Tell your skeptical customers about ENERGY STAR certification and the benefits of ENERGY STAR certified refrigerators:

- “To earn the ENERGY STAR, refrigerators are independently certified based on testing in an EPA recognized lab to meet **strict energy-efficiency guidelines.**”
- “You can find the ENERGY STAR label on the most advanced refrigerators in a variety of designs. Many also use innovative drawer designs and improved temperature controls to keep your food fresher, longer.”
- “Look for the **ENERGY STAR logo** and the product listing on the ENERGY STAR [product finder.](#)”

“How do I know it’s really ENERGY STAR?”

Look for the simple choice for energy efficiency.

What is it?

- A distinction that recognizes products that deliver cutting edge energy efficiency along with the latest in technological innovation.
- It represents the “best of the best” among those that qualify for ENERGY STAR in a given year.

Why is it important to your customers?
