DEAR ENERGY STAR PARTNER,

Revision 12 of the ENERGY STAR <u>Single-Family New Homes (SFNH) program</u> and Revision 03 of the ENERGY STAR <u>Multifamily New Construction (MFNC) program</u> have been posted. As a reminder, Revisions typically clarify, simplify, and improve the program, rather than increase the overall stringency of the requirements. Partners are permitted to use these Revisions immediately, at their discretion, but must apply them to all homes and apartments permitted on or after January 1, 2024.

EPA strongly encourages partners to review the <u>SFNH Highlights</u> and <u>MFNC Highlights</u> documents to understand the most important improvements.

In addition, SFNH and MFNC 'Mark-Up' documents showing tracked changes, as well as the Current Policy Record containing all policy issues, are available on the Policy Clarifications and Changes webpage.
