## DEAR ENERGY STAR RESIDENTIAL STAKEHOLDER,

On January 30, 2023, President Biden announced that the national COVID emergency would be lifted on May 11, 2023. As a result, EPA's temporary allowance for the visual verification of ENERGY STAR and Indoor airPLUS checklist items to be performed remotely using audio/visual connections will expire on **June 11, 2023**. This is consistent with EPA's <u>previous policy</u> announcements stating that the temporary allowance would expire thirty (30) days after the Presidential Proclamation on Declaring a National Emergency Concerning the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak is lifted. After EPA's temporary allowance expires on June 11, 2023, completion of onsite diagnostic tests required to certify a home or apartment as ENERGY STAR and/or Indoor airPLUS can no longer be deferred to a later date.
