If you work on behalf of more than one organization that is partnered with the ENERGY STAR program, you are expected to complete a separate update for each organization.

To streamline your response, we suggest organizing the following information before beginning the update:

- Brief (1,000 character limit) overview of your incentive program to be featured on the ENERGY STAR Nationwide Incentive List.
- Total number of single-family and manufactured homes, and multifamily units for which incentives were provided by your program in 2021 and general projections for 2022.
- An understanding of your residential new construction program design details to answer a series of multiple-choice questions.
