

Nadarajah Narendran is the director of research at the Lighting Research Center and a professor in the School of Architecture at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York. Dr. Narendran is well known throughout the lighting industry for his pioneering research in the field of solid-state lighting. His focus is in the areas of LED performance, packaging, and lighting application. He leads the Alliance for Solid-State Illumination Systems and Technologies (ASSIST), an international organization of researchers, manufacturers, and government agencies dedicated to overcoming the technological hurdles facing LED lighting and helping speed its market acceptance. Narendran has authored more than 100 articles in archival journals and proceedings and holds several patents. He is a Fellow of the Illuminating Engineering Society of North America and a member of the committee on the assessment of solid-state lighting for the National Research Council of The National Academies.
